Getting Better Fuel Economy

Rolling resistance is a combination of tire design, construction, alignment, and proper air pressure. Drivers can help themselves by ensuring proper air pressure is maintained.

Aerodynamic drag is caused by three main factors, which are speed, coefficient of drag, and frontal area. The driver can only control speed.

Acceleration is the major user of energy. Drivers can control how quickly they accelerate.

Idling is also a major factor in fuel

economy and is easy to cure. Drivers should shut down whenever they can. Several states are writing or currently have legislation in place prohibiting idling beyond 3-5 minutes.




Safety Blog - Road Check 2016

This year's 72-hour Roadcheck takes place from June 7-9, so it's time to start thinking about how to prepare for the annual enforcement program.

Roadside inspection officers will be out in full force conducting vehicle and driver inspections of commercial vehicles traveling the highways.

Of the 69,472 inspections conducted in the 2015 Roadcheck, 21.6% of the vehicles were found to have out-ofservice violations and 3.6% of the drivers were found with



out-of-service violations.


Keeping our Cargo Safe

Everyone at MDS has a duty and responsibility of keeping our yards and facilities secure from theft.

As we are all aware, the thieves are getting smarter, more aggressive and more selective in their targets. These individuals are able to identify the loads that carry high-value goods. Plus, their techniques for pulling off the heist have grown so sophisticated it takes a lot more than a simple lock to stop them.

According to CargoNet's an-

report, cargo thefts industrywide numbered 844 in 2014. That equates to an average of 70 truckload theft incidents each month in the United States.



Though the industry shows continuing decline in number of

cargo thefts, the value per theft

increased nearly 18% in 2014. Cargo theft rates are again on the rise in 2015, increasing year

over year in the first quarter according to FreightWatch International.

We need to ensure that all loads on our yards are being secured properly everyday. We need to make sure all yards and facilities are locked and notify authorities asap of any unusual activity.






Revenue Report
